All classes will be held with rules and regulations which are accustomed to registered breed shows referring to the way of going and use of equipment unless otherwise specified in class patterns or class definition.

All exhibitors must show in appropriate show attire.

All exhibitors must hold themselves to a high level of integrity and honesty while at events.

All disputes will be reviewed and finalized by Frank Chick Jr. and chosen knowledgeable peers.

Exhibitors must have a NEGATIVE coggins test within twelve months of each show date.

Mid-Atlantic Dream Series & Gambler's Choice Equestrian Center will not be held responsible for any injuries, damages or loss of property at any show or event.

Stalls are available at \$30 a day and include water and bedding.

Age of ALL exhibitors for the 2010 show year will be his or her age as of January 1, 2010.

Judges will have final say on ALL decisions regarding soundness, ring conduct and unsafe horses

Definitions

Halter

1. AQHA – Registered American Quarter Horse
2. APHA – Registered American Paint Horse
3. ApHC – Registered Appaloosa Horse Club
4. All Age – Horses of all ages
5. All Breed – All registered & non-registered horses
6. Miniature Horse – horses of all ages & all sexes with a height of 38" & under
7. Pony – All ages & all sexes 9.3 Hands to 14.2 Hands
8. Performance – All horses also shown under saddle
9. Leadline – Children 6 years old & under

Age Groups

1. Small Fry – Exhibitors 10 years old & under
2. Youth – Exhibitors 18 years old & under
3. Youth 13 & Under – Exhibitors 13 years old & under
4. Youth 14 -18 – Exhibitors 14 to 18 years of age
5. Adult – Exhibitors 19 years old & up

Performance

1. Pleasure Driving – Horse of all breeds & all ages shown harnessed to a safe vehicle
2. Walk/Trot – Horses of all breeds & all ages shown under english tack
3. Walk/Jog - Horses of all breeds & all ages shown under western tack
4. Small Fry – All classes will be shown at a walk & trot or walk & jog gate
5. Green – All horses 2 & 3 years old shown in a smooth snaffle ring bit or hackamore
6. Junior – All horses 5 years old & under
7. Senior – All horses 6 years old & older
